## ALL YOU NEED TO KNOW: TENNIS WORLD MELBOURNE AO HOLIDAY PROGRAM X WEETBIX

### FOUNDATIONAL INFORMATION

#### LOCATION:

National Tennis Centre on the **Clay Courts**.

There will be **NO parking** available for parents to drop their children. You will need to walk your child to the designated drop-off and pick-up zone.

We highly recommend using public transport. The closest and most efficient spots to get off and walk are:

- Tram 70 – Stop 7D (Olympic Boulevard)
- Richmond Station
- Bus 246 – To Clifton Hill Interchange/Queens Pde
- Bus 246 – To Elsternwick Station/ Horne St

#### DROP-OFF AND PICK-UP:





Drop-off and pick-up are located off Olympic Park, opposite Aami Park. This is indicated on the map above. There is no formal entry, as there is restricted access into the Australian Open grounds and thus children need a pass before entering.

Please ensure you arrive 15 minutes early as there will be no opportunity after to be let in.

This applies for pick-up as well, if for any reason you need to pick your child up earlier or later, please let the coach know at your earliest convenience.

#### WHAT TO BRING:

You will need to bring a racquet, water bottle, hat, sunscreen and a team spirit!

Please make sure you pack snacks and lunch for the kids too. We do not cater for the kids, nor will there be a chance for purchasing food.
